

THE LIVING MUSEUM OF GINGERBREADS

The Living Museum of Gingerbreads in Toruń is the first so interactive museum in Europe. It has existed since 2006 and it is located at 9 Rabiańska street, in the middle of the city center (199 steps from The Nicolas Copernicus Monument).

Crossing the gates of the Museum will guarantee you two time travels:

- **the first floor** magically takes the visitors to the **Medieval times**. Here you can learn about every ritual connected with baking gingerbreads. It all takes place under the watchful eyes of m **Gingerbread Master** and charming **Gingerbread Witch**. The visitors **prepare dough by themselves** and then **bake** the specialties of Toruń in traditional **wooden molds**.
- **the second floor** is a manufacturing room from the **19th and the early 20th** century, managed by the Rabiański siblings. Here the visitors will see, for example, the original German **machines** (which were used to bake gingerbreads), a vintage baking oven and the collection of wax gingerbread molds. What is more, everyone has a chance to **decorate their own gingerbread** with icing and take part in gingerbread decorating workshop led by the rzez Painter.
